RULES:

1. Entries are open to all amateur flower growers in Delaware County.
2. Exhibitors are responsible for all property.
3. Exhibitors may enter as many classes as desired but only one entry per number in each class is allowed.
4. HORTICULTURE EXHIBITS must be displayed in containers furnished by the committee, except for Tuberous Begonia.
5. Ribbons will be awarded for 4 places.
6. A Best of Show ribbon will be awarded in memory of Rosalie Oswald.
7. Fresh plant material must be used in all artistic designs unless otherwise stated.
8. NICHES must be in place by 9:00 a.m., Saturday, September 15, 2007; Monday, September 17, 2007; and Wednesday, September 19, 2007 & Friday, September 21, 2007.
9. Entries for GOURD COLLECTIONS and HOUSE PLANTS must be in place by 11:00 a.m. Saturday, September 15, 2007.
10. Entries for HORTICULTURE EXHIBITS must be in place by 11:00 a.m., Saturday, September 5, 2007 and Wednesday, September 19, 2007.
11. ARTISTIC DESIGNS to be in place by 11:00 a.m., Saturday, September 15, 2007 and Wednesday, September 19, 2007.
12. Judging will begin at 12:00 noon, Saturday, September, 15, 2007 and Wednesday, September 19, 2007.
13. Saturday's ARTISTIC DESIGNS and HORTICULTURE EXHIBITS released Tuesday, September 18, 2007 at 5:30 p.m.
14. GOURDS and HOUSE PLANTS ARE NOT TO BE REMOVED UNTIL 7:00 p.m., Saturday, September 22, 2007.
15. Accessories may be used as long as they are secured to the mechanics or base and are within the design itself.
16. Greenhouse material not to be used except in Niches.
17. No artificial, painted, or artificially colored flowers or Foliage permitted.
18. NO ARTISTIC DESIGN, HOUSE PLANT OR HERB EXHIBIT TO EXCEED 20 INCHES IN WIDTH.
19. Entries will be judged by the Standard System, Ohio Association of Garden Clubs.
20. NICHES by Garden Clubs on invitation only.
21. **All entries released Saturday, September 22, 2007 at 7:00 p.m.**
22. **All entries and ribbons MUST be picked up by 12:00 noon Sunday, September 23, 2007.**

Pots including plants over 20 inches in width **WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**. Entries to be single EXCEPT CLASSES 1, 2, 10 and 11. All plants must be ESTABLISHED and ROOTBOUND. Drainage saucer compatible to container must be furnished by Exhibitor.
