Judges and Superintendents shall have the right to open all cans of fruits, vegetables, jellies, preserves and butters. Fruits must be in natural juices and canned within the last year. All fruits must be in regulation quart cans with new bands and lids. Preserves, butters and pickles must be in regulation pint jars. Jellies must be in eight ounce regulation jelly glasses. They must be sealed and have new bands and lids.
