All Precautions will be taken to protect exhibits, but management will not be responsible for lost or damaged items. Exhibits will be released the Sunday after fair from 9:00 A.M. - 3:00 P.M. Exhibits may not be removed prior to release. Anything left will be taken to the Fair Office and disposed of after two weeks if not claimed.

Additional Criteria for Antiques:

1. Antique Dealers are not eligible to exhibit.
2. Article must be at least 50 years old and in a good state of preservation.
3. Due to limited showcase space, exhibits are limited to two items per entry unless specified.
4. All articles will be exhibited with proper protection for handling and possible theft. The fair will use all reasonable care to protect and insure the safety of articles entered but will under no circumstances be responsible for any loss or breakage that may occur.
5. No premium will be given if exhibit is considered unworthy by the judge and the decision of the judge is final in all classes.

SECTION Q – SCRAPBOOKING

Additional Criteria for Scrapbooking:

1. Have a hard front and back cover with pages firmly attached between the covers.
2. Contain at least 10 completed pages.
3. Be at least 8" by 10" (no smaller) but not larger than standard scrapbook pages (12" by 12".)
4. A theme is desired but not required. If a theme is used, it should be based on a specific theme (family, friends, event, person, baby, holiday, vacation, pets, etc.)
4. Scrapbooking 'Three Rules of Three' should be used, but are not required. The 'Three Rules of Three' pertain to embellishments, photos and color.

SECTION R - SCARECROW

Exhibits to be in place by 9:00 A.M. the first Saturday of the fair.

Additional Criteria for Scarecrows:

1. All exhibits must be flame retardant. All exhibits must be free standing. All supports must be concealed or an integral part of the exhibit.
2. Materials should be handmade. No living plant material may be used. If vegetables or fruit are used, they must not be punctured or carved and must remain fresh in appearance and texture.
3. Exhibitors should use good taste and judgment when planning their entry. Scarecrows should be tasteful, lovable, mischievous and humorous; not frightening.
4. Judging, criteria: Originality, quality, attractiveness, theme interpretation, and construction.
