Delaware County Antique Tractor Pulling Rules

With the Delaware County Fair

GENERAL RULES:

- 1. Tractors 1980 and older
- 2. Weight classes are: 3500 lbs. to 12500 lbs.
- 3. Two-wheel drive only. No duals. No steel wheels.
- **4.** The order of pull will be determined by the order of registration. A number indicating the class and order of the pull will be assigned to each driver at registration.
 - If you miss your class 1st call, you'll be moved to the last pull in that class.
 - If you miss the final call, you will be pulled from that class with no pull and no refund will be given.
- 5. Registration must be paid **BEFORE** pull starts.
 - Each hook \$10 cash + Gate fee
 - Pay for each class at the time of registration.
 - Nonrefundable
- **6.** All drivers & drivers' guardians must sign the release form at sign up.
- 7. Officials' decisions are FINAL.
- 8. All class drivers MUST attend the driver's meeting 15 minutes prior to the start of the pulls.
 - Sign up starts @ 4:00 pm
 - Driver meeting @ 5:45 pm
 - First pulls start @ 6:00 pm
- **9.** No Rain Date will be scheduled.

AGE:

10. Drivers must be 18 years old or older, or 16 years of age with parent present.

SAFETY:

- 11. No alcoholic beverages permitted for pullers during pulls.
- 12. Drivers must obey all signals from flagmen.
- 13. All participants pull at their own risk.
- **14.** All weights must be securely and/or bolted on.
- 15. <u>Safety is our utmost concern: The Delaware County Fair Board are in no way responsible for accidents or articles lost or stolen.</u>
 - 2 Tracks will be utilized for tractor pulls.

Speed:

16. Speed

- If you exceed speed your first signal will be given as a warning.
- If your speed exceeds again your second signal will result in a disqualification of the pull with no refund.
- See below for your class specific speed.
- 17. Max Draw bar height 18" inches.
- 18. If weight is adjusted after the pullers first pull, puller will be required to repull.
- **19.** Must have your own clevis for pulling.
- 20. Tractor tires must always stay inside the marked boundaries while pulling.
- **21.** The pullers have two attempts at pull; they may change gear and may restart if the puller stops before the marked cones on the track. (before the sled crosses the line)
- **22.** Any parts falling from the tractor after being hooked to the sled and until tractor is unhooked from sled, will results in a disqualification.

Farm Stock Class

- Speed limit 5 mph
- NO cut tires.
- 3500, 4500, 5500, 6500, 7500, 8500, 9500, 10500, 11500, 12500 Classes

Cut Tire Class

- Speed limit 10 mph
- Cut tires allowed.
- Will be a floating finish.
- 6500, 7500, 8500, 9500, 10500, 11500, 12500 Classes
