

# **Delaware County Antique Tractor Pulling Rules 2025 with the Delaware County Fair**

## **GENERAL RULES:**

1. Tractors 1980 and older
2. Weight classes are: 3500 lbs. to 12500 lbs +
3. Two-wheel drive only. No duals. No steel wheels.
4. The order of pull will be determined by the order of registration. A number indicating the class and order of the pull will be assigned to each driver at registration.
  - If you miss your class 1<sup>st</sup> call, you'll be moved to the last pull in that class.
  - If you miss the final call, you will be pulled from that class with no pull and no refund will be given.
5. Registration must be paid **BEFORE** pull starts.
  - Each hook \$10 cash + Gate fee
  - Pay for each class at the time of registration.
  - Nonrefundable
6. All drivers & drivers' guardians must sign the release form at sign up.
7. Officials' decisions are FINAL.
8. All class drivers **MUST** attend the driver's meeting 15 minutes prior to the start of the pulls.
  - **Sign up starts @ 2:00 pm**
  - **Driver meeting @ 3:45 pm**
  - **First pulls start @ 4:00 pm**
9. No Rain Date will be scheduled.
10. Drivers must be 18 years old or older, or 16 years of age *with parent present*.
11. Parent/Guardian must sign the liability waiver.

## **SAFETY:**

12. No alcoholic beverages permitted for pullers during pulls.
13. Drivers must obey all signals from flagmen.

14. All participants pull at their own risk.
15. All weights must be securely and/or bolted on.
16. *Safety is our outmost concern:* The Delaware County Fair Board are in no way responsible for accidents or articles lost or stolen.
17. **SPEED:**
  - If you exceed speed your first signal will be given as a warning.
  - If your speed exceeds again your second signal will result in a disqualification of the pull with no refund.
  - *See below for your class specific speed.*
18. Max Draw bar height 18" inches.
19. If weight is adjusted after the pullers first pull, puller will be required to repull.
20. Must have your own clevis for pulling.
21. Tractor tires must always stay inside the marked boundaries while pulling.
22. The pullers have two attempts at pull; they may change gear and may restart if the puller stops before the marked cones on the track. (*before the sled crosses the line*)
23. Any parts falling off of the tractor after being hooked to sled and until tractor is unhooked from sled, will result in a disqualification.
24. All classes need a minimum of 3 entries with different drivers or same driver with different tractors
25. Tractor will/can be bumped into next class if there are not enough entries

### **Classes**

- Speed limit determined by sled operator
- Cut tires allowed
- Will be a floating finish
- 3500, 4500, 5500, 6500, 7500, 8500, 9500, 10500, 11500, 12500, 12500+ Classes
