

2026 Delaware County Fair Rough Truck Rules

Driver Entry Fee \$20.00

Top 10 in each class will receive prize money.

Each Class will run once

Event Times:

Registration and Vehicle Inspection: 4:00PM – 6:30PM

Drivers Meeting: 6:30PM – 6:45PM

Driver Line-Up Assignment: 6:45PM – 7:00PM

Vehicle Classes:

1. **Stock** - Any ordinary, street-legal pickup truck or SUV that retains its factory-produced powertrain, suspension, and chassis
2. **Modified** – Any alterations to suspension, drivetrain, or chassis that go beyond factory specifications, or if it exceeds stock class limits for tire size and lift height

Vehicle Regulations:

1. All vehicles must be equipped with Department of Transportation (DOT)–approved seat belts, and all seats must be securely fastened to the floor.
2. All vehicles must have fully functional brakes.
3. Only street-legal tires are permitted. Tractor tires are prohibited.
4. Fuel must be gasoline or diesel only. Nitrous oxide and fuel additives of any kind are strictly prohibited.
5. No loose items are allowed in the truck bed.
6. All vehicles will be inspected by the Motorsports Committee. Approval by the Motorsports Committee indicates only that the vehicle is permitted to participate in the Rough Truck event and does not guarantee that the vehicle is mechanically sound. The Motorsports Committee and the Delaware County Agricultural Society are not liable for any mechanical failure, loss, injury, or death resulting from participation.
7. Entry fees are non-refundable after the drivers' meeting has been concluded.
8. No driver or vehicle changes are permitted after registration and the drivers' meeting has been completed.
9. Only golf carts registered through the Delaware County Fair are permitted on the grounds. NO ATVS or UTV's on grounds other than inside the pit area fencing.

Driver Regulations:

All Driver Must:

1. Be at least 18 years of age and possess a valid driver's license.
2. Pay a \$20 driver fee, which includes entry for the driver **ONLY**. All other individuals in the pit area must either proceed to the general admission area or purchase a pit pass at the ticket booth. Any person who does not comply may be removed, and the driver may be subject to

disqualification at the discretion of a Motorsports Committee member.

3. Present a valid driver's license to a Track Official and/or Motorsports Committee member to claim any winnings.
4. Register entries in the driver's name only. Only one driver is permitted per vehicle.
5. Wear a properly secured seat belt or safety harness and a Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC)–approved helmet (full-face helmet recommended). The chin strap must be secured at all times while on the track.
6. Wear protective eyewear, helmet, a shirt, closed toe shoes, and full-length jeans (no cut-offs).
7. Provide their own vehicle and furnish proof of ownership upon request.
8. Attend the drivers' meeting prior to the event.
9. Remain inside the vehicle at all times during racing unless instructed otherwise by a Track Official.
10. Keep head, arms, and legs inside the vehicle at all times while racing.
11. ONLY drivers and track officials are permitted on staging areas. No driver shall be on staging area unless in current class.
12. Absolutely NO passengers are permitted in vehicles during racing.
13. Not be pregnant.

Racing Regulations:

Violations of any of the following rules may result in disqualification.

1. Decisions of the Motorsports Committee is FINAL! No call can be overturned. You may be refused the Right to compete for any just reason. Absolutely No arguing, verbal abuse, or fighting will be tolerated. This conduct will result in immediate Disqualification and forfeiture of prize money and immediate expelling from grounds and from this event for life. If you object to any ruling, you must forward a written complaint to the Motorsports Committee.
2. Absolutely No person will be allowed to compete under the influence of drugs or alcohol. No alcohol or drugs will be allowed in the pit or restricted area. Subject to disqualification and expulsion from grounds.
3. Each driver or pit person entering the restricted or pit area must understand, sign and date the release and waiver of liability & indemnity agreement at the pit registration window.
4. Once your vehicle is even partially inspected, there shall be no refunds of entry money.
5. Any person will be held personally liable for contaminating the soil of the event grounds by spilling of Fluids, or by littering of grounds with any material other than water or metal. Offenders shall be disqualified, expelled from the grounds and in some cases face prosecution. No refueling or adding of fluids will be permitted without funnel and/or siphon hose for proper installation.
6. Once your vehicle has been inspected your vehicle must not leave the grounds for repair of any nature.
7. All restricted or pit area entrants must be at least 18 years of age, or accompanied by an adult, and have signed the "Rough Truck Pit Area Waiver of Liability." All pit entrants must not be intoxicated or under the influence of any drugs or mind-altering medication. No pit entrant may stand within twenty (20) feet of wheel barriers used to contain vehicles competing on the track. No pit entrant may stand within fifty (50) feet of an opening in the

wheel barriers used as an arena gate. No pit entrant may stand against any fence with less than twenty (20) feet between such fence and moving vehicles. No person, other than a trained professional, shall attempt to care for any injured pit entrant. Absolutely NO fireperson, E.M.T. rescue personnel or signed in pit entrant shall be allowed to enter the arena until approval from the track officials has been given.

8. Absolutely NO person, participant or support vehicle driver, shall be permitted to exceed Five (5) M.P.H. in the restricted or pit area, as well as anywhere on the grounds.
9. No support people, such as but not limited to, firepersons, E.M.T.'s, tow truck or pull-off equipment drivers, track officials or rescue personnel shall be permitted to enter the restricted or pit area without first signing release form.
10. Absolutely NO person shall be permitted to enter the restricted area without understanding that each person that signs and dates the Release and Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement voluntarily acknowledges that each person is entering at their own risk and accepts total responsibility for any circumstances which may result. NO person shall enter the pit area if
11. Under a Physician's care or Pregnant.
12. Transporting of participating vehicles to and from the event must meet all D.O.T. highway safety codes.
13. Driver Door of all vehicles must not come open during any event.
